## **WHO QUALIFIES?**

Individuals with **college degrees\*** in **Psychology, Sociology, Human Services, Nursing, and many other disciplines** may now apply for *equivalency* toward the advanced **CATC III, CATC IV, CATC V, or CATC N** credentials offered by CAADE.

*\*Degrees must be from regionally accredited colleges and universities only.*

## **WHAT IS TIAC's CAADE TRACK?**

CAADE approved equivalency applicants must complete a minimum number of addiction-specific courses to qualify for the CATC. **TIAC's CAADE track offers the addiction courses** necessary to meet the education requirements for the advanced CATC credential. Tracks can be individualized and courses are available on weekends for working adults.
